



Are you working as a
Non-Domestic **GAS**
Installer/Service/Repair Engineer?
If so, you should read this:

The scope of the Registered Gas Installers (RGI) Scheme is being extended to include Non-Domestic Gas Works. It is expected that a new Regulation making it mandatory that Non-Domestic Gas Installers are registered will commence in January 2019.

A voluntary register is **now open** on www.rgii.ie. It is **free** to register. If you are an Installer working on Non-Domestic Gas Works, you should register on the voluntary register as your qualifications will require validation prior to finalising scheme entry requirements.

Please note that submitting provisional registration details does not guarantee acceptance onto the mandatory register when it opens in 2019.

The RGII has responsibility for regulating Domestic Gas Works since June 2009. The scope of the RGII will be extended to include Non-Domestic Gas Works in 2019 including pipework, space heating, hot water, catering, laundry, power generation and CHP installations.
